# PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

such that while some people break under stress, others are spurred on to break records. It is my sincerest wish that all of you fall into the second category of people.


To those of you who have to walk these halls for an additional year or two let me say this: that out of every endeavour you will get only as much as you are willing to put into it.


# STUDENT COUNCIL

#### **RENDEVOUS '67**

In mid August four hundred and fifty delegates from forty-five countries arrived at Carlton University in Ottawa. Prior to this each international delegate had lived with a Canadian family in various parts of Canada for two weeks. Now, home hospitality was over, and the conference itself, a time for an exchange of ideas had begun. This was "a happening", and it was the Canadian Red Cross's centennial project "Rendezvous 67" an international youth conference. This conference was unique in that it was organized by youth for youth, and it was the largest conference of its type ever held.

Rendezvous 67 brought the realization that the youth from all countries are genuinely concerned about the problems confronting today's world. This conference was rich in ideas, ideals, and thoughts that should prove beneficial in forthcoming years.

Regardless of race or creed the delegates were bonded together by a desire to endeavour to improve the lot of mankind, and to attempt to unite other nations to this goal. Through a free give and take, which often became heated with passionate convictions the delegates explained problems facing Red Cross in their country and sought guidance from others. Solutions were not always readily available but attempts were made to parallel their problems to one's facing others.

Rendezvous 67 was a rewarding experience and I am grateful for the opportunity it afforded in meeting so many representatives from so many countries; and sharing with them not only the happy exuberance of youth, but the many and varied problems common to us all. This conference provided all with a vast knowledge of programs that could be implimented in their own areas.

The conference now over, the delegates could look back on the hours of discussions spent each day, the singsongs, and the games. They would never forget their visit to Montreal, Expo, Kingston and Toronto. For wherever they went so did their good times and their constant quest for knowledge.

We had something intangible, yet tangible. Even though no definite solutions were resolved the delegates all left for their respective homes united in their desire to share this experience with others, and to endeavour to stimulate an active interest in the Red Cross and the betterment of mankind, not only in their own country but in those of others. A quote from an unknown writer best sums up their ideals:

"I sought my soul
My soul I could not see
I sought my God
But he eluded me
I sought my brother
And found all three"

Despite the formidable task, the team tackled the season in a determined style, and were knocked out of the play-offs only after a second overtime defeat at the hands of Vincent Massey.


