This year has been one of change at Glenlawn Collegiate The School day was extended. Individualized scheduling was attempted by computer. Students were given more "freedom and responsibility".



VALEDICTORY ADDRESS

Mr. Darenchuk, honored guests, fellow graduates and parents. When I came back to Glenlawn, for a visit a couple of weeks ago, I realized just how much I missed this place, and wished I had visited sooner. I was astonished however at the many changes. I've heard about the changes, now I have seen them, and I can't help thinking that I can almost feel them. Glenlawn Collegiate Institute has changed a great deal in every respect. But as much as Glenlawn has changed, education has remained the same. The principles of education mean an awful lot more to me now than they did as a freshman three years ago.

Twenty three hundred years ago Plato said in his book "THE REPUBLIC" that the ultimate aim of education is the training of character and I think that this holds true even more so today. High School is one step of education, it is not however, the last step no matter what we plan on doing next, because education is not just found in text books and class rooms, Education is defined in modern dictionaries as the "development of the whole nature of man, physical, intellectual and moral through interaction with every phase of his environment."

Glenlawn qualifies as an educational institution much more than we realize on the surface. Glenlawn is text books, teachers, and classrooms. Glenlawn is gymnasiums, sports, and physical education. Glenlawn is dances, class parties, new friends, new enemies, new interests, new expectations, and new failures.

Moreover Glenlawn is experience. Every student has an obligation to himself. That obligation is to develop his potential to the best of his ability.

It is a sad but indisputable fact that most human beings go through life only partially aware of the full range of their abilities. To develop this potential one must be educated and education leads us again to the realm of experience. The period of greatest development falls in fact, in adolescent years as does high school. And we see from this how high school must shoulder the burden of providing the experiences necessary for development of potential.

We come to high school as freshmen. We study at least three years. What do we study?? Shortcuts of better living? How to make money fast? How to bring up our children? Nooo Nothing so simple.

Nothing that prepares us for adulthood so quickly. Instead we learn what year the battle of Hastings was fought, and how elements in a sugar molecule and why???? Not because it will help us to bring our children up or to be better adults but because it develops our minds. The questions get harder and harder, and the work load gets heavier and heavier and heavier and it's all for one purpose, to develop our minds so that we can be more intelligent and so that we can figure out for ourselves how to earn good money, or bring up our children.

Everything in all the text books is knowledge and knowledge consists of things that are known; intelligence stems from knowledge and relates these known things to things yet unknown and incorporates them in the production of new ideas. So we see that intelligence, and the development of it, is one aspect of our education, and there are others.

Education doesn't include only text book knowledge but many other types of experiences. Education is also meeting new people, going to dances, parties, and basketball games. Experiences like being swept into school politics, joining new clubs, playing on new teams, and many more. Many more that when we think of them, all happen right here at Glenlawn.

So Glenlawn provided for us and continues to provide the many experiences necessary in the make-up of an education. And these experiences when we partake of them think about them, learn from them, mix them up, and digest them will gradually (and it takes three years) evelve into an identity. An identity which is the main product of an education, an identity that is made up of reactions to experience, and identity which will be unique to each and everyone of us. An identity which we found, for the most part at Glenlawn.




The spring dance is being planned now. The tentative date and band is March 21st and "The Mongrels".



Words! O words, please fall in place; All enrolled in Webster's waste! Of so many, a few could fit; And express just how my feelings sit.




Varsity Girls


Freshmen Girls
