
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Regard your present situation as only the sketch of a picture which must be finished. If you do not try to do a little more or a little better than you can do easily you will never find out the best you are capable of doing.
































PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE






EDITOR'S MESSAGE

PEP CLUB




UNITED NATIONS CLUB


