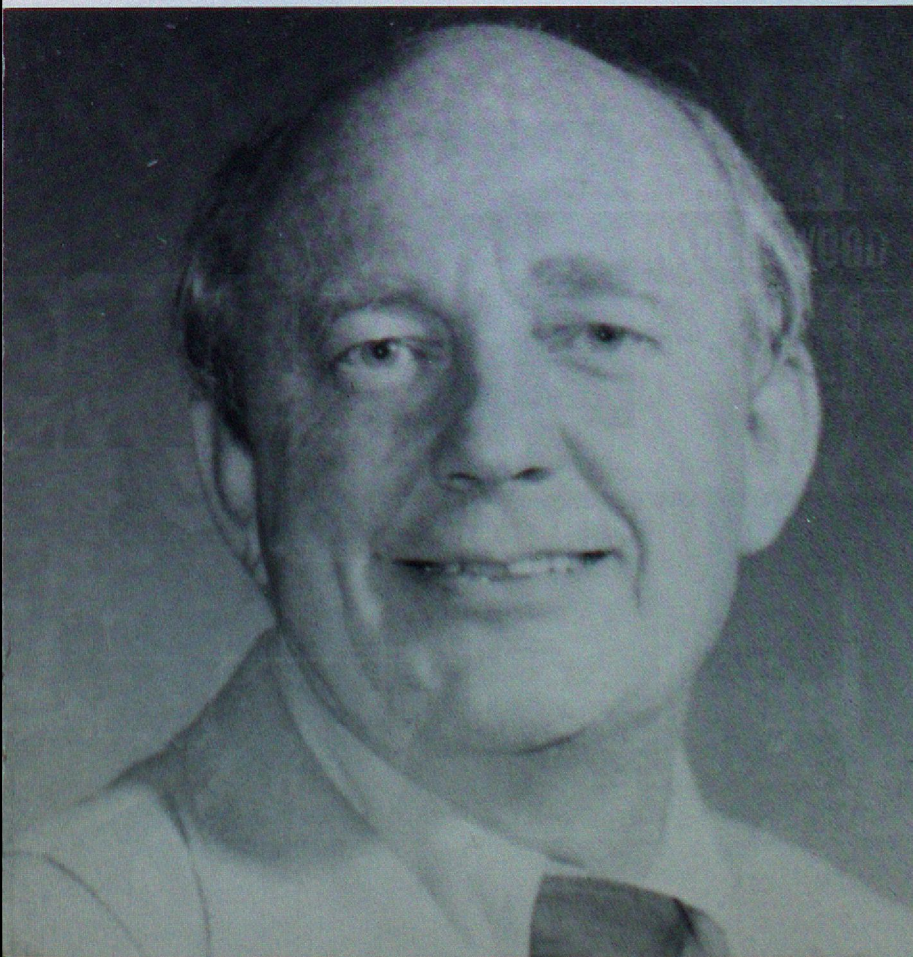


# *Principal's Message*

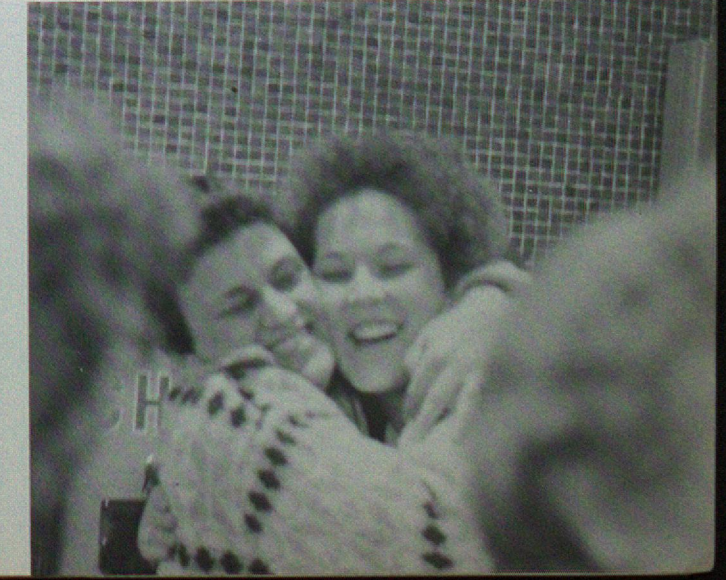


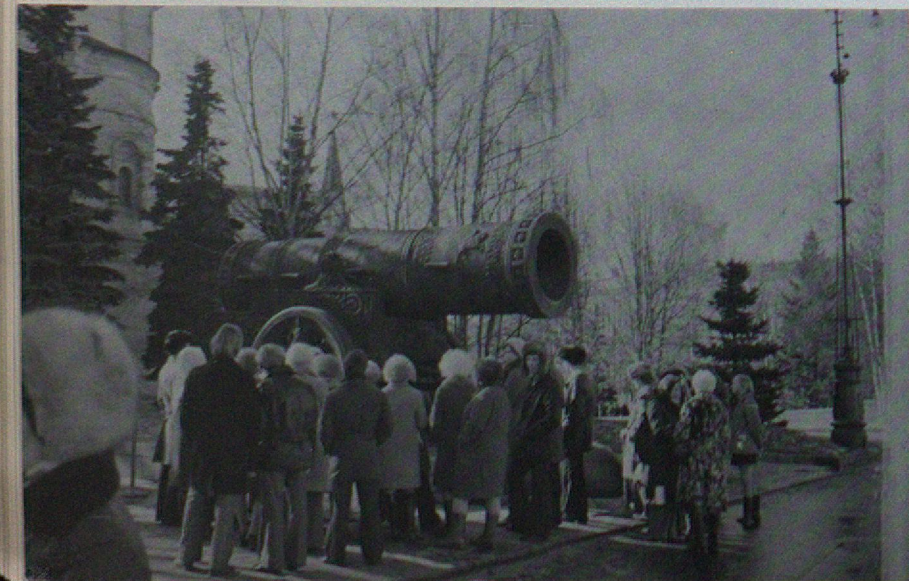
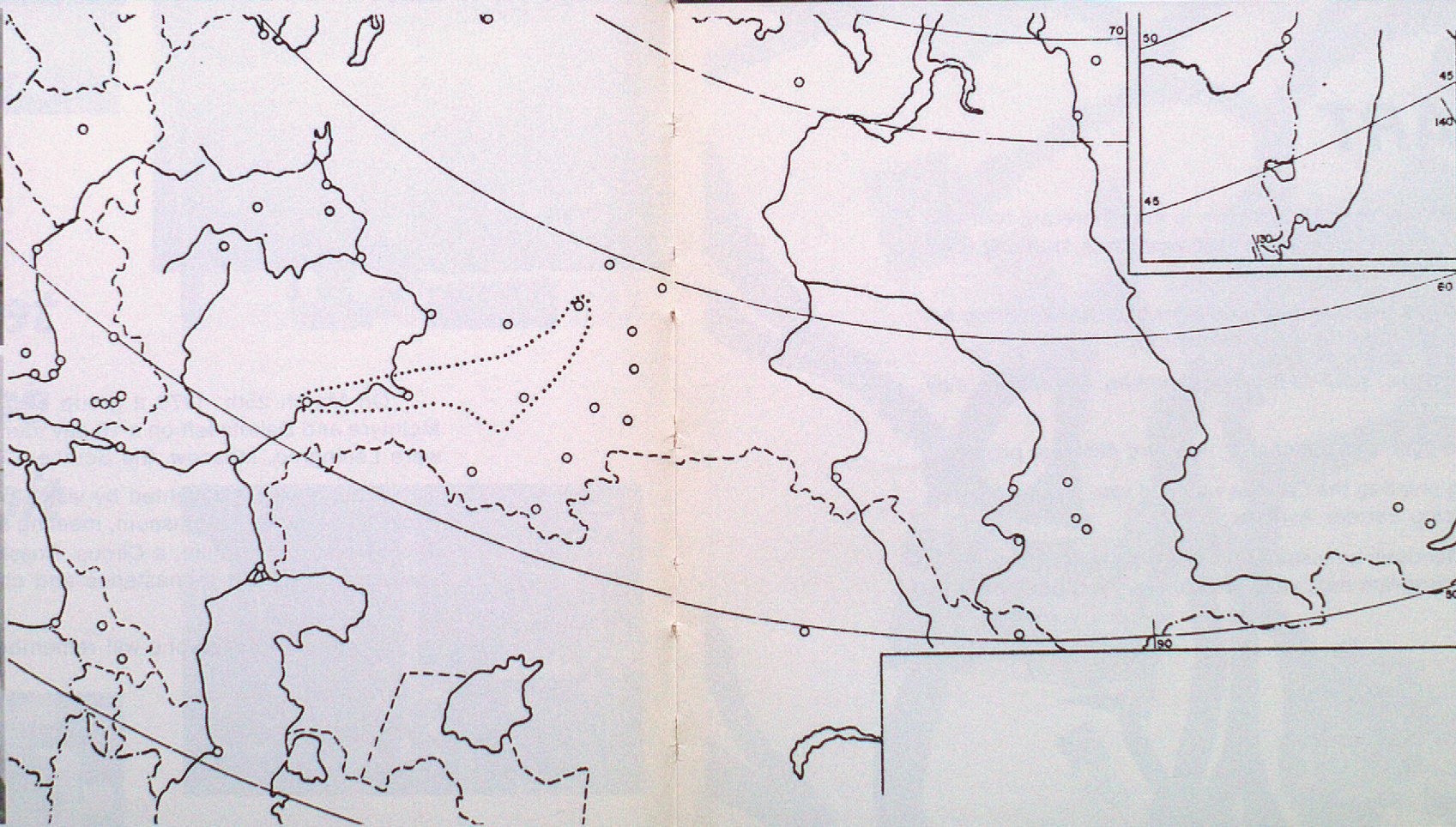
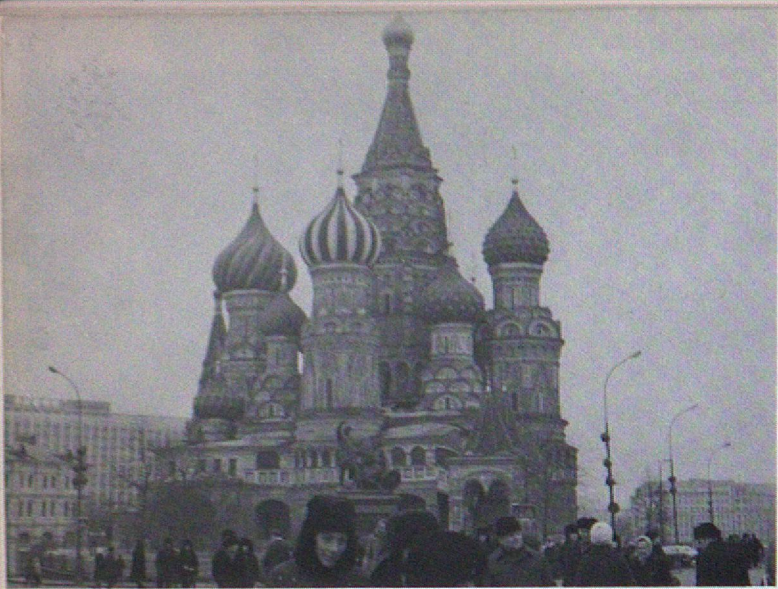
## *RUSSIA TRIP*

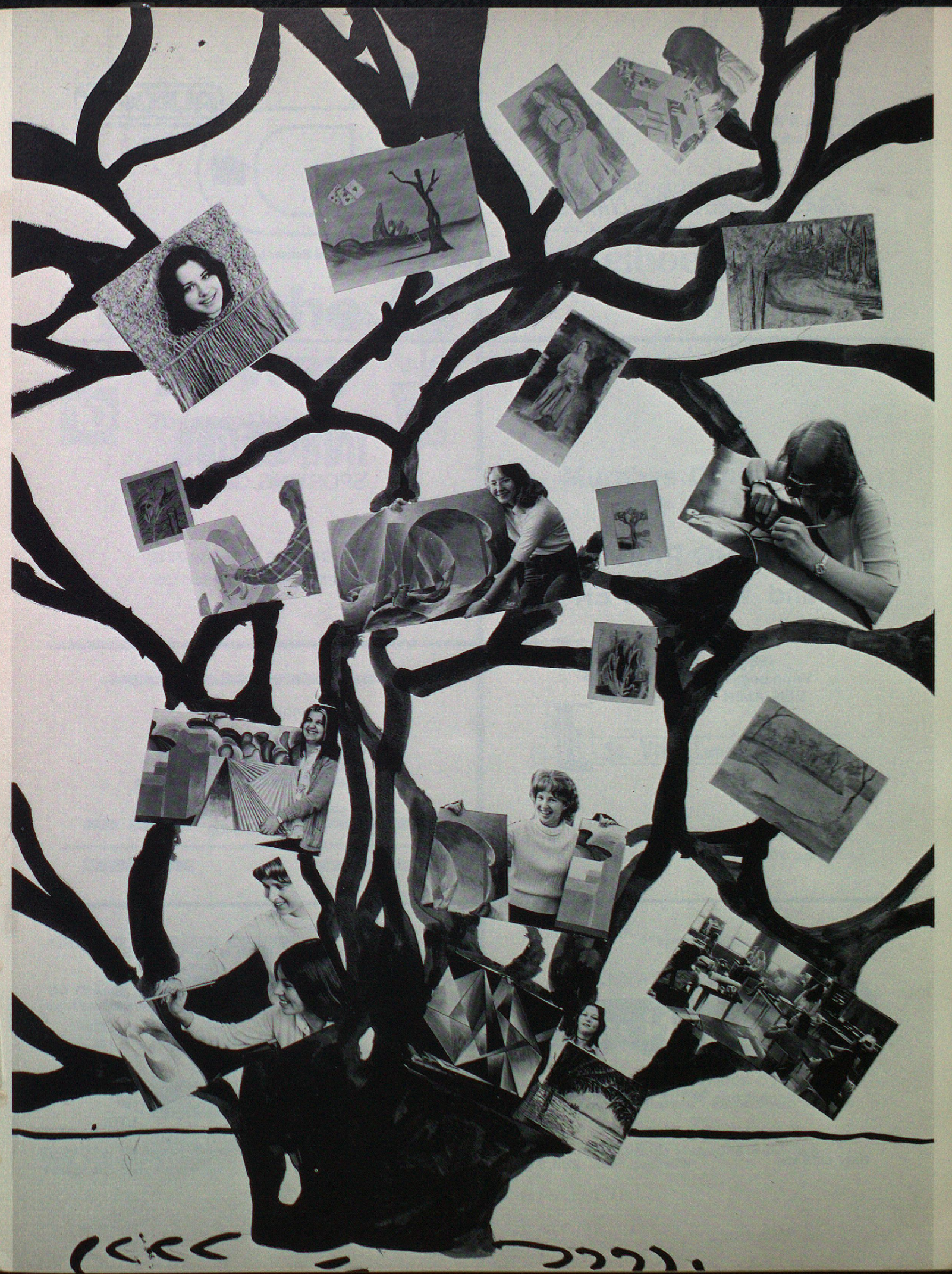
Throughout the year, the Art class has been on many field trips to the Winnipeg Art Gallery, the Forum Art Institute and to St. Vital Park (for sketching).
