


Unfortunately, the latter freedom frequently, in these days, degenerates into licence and is all too often used by pressure groups to foist their views of humna progress on others by violent means.


At Glenlawn, your teachers continue to attempt to provide an education in terms of the second quotation, yet their efforts are not enough.

But it's worth it.






Principal's Message


There was only one minor injury and Nurse Bagley kept everything under control. All in all, the day was a success and all the skiers hope that there will be many more ski buses in the future.





























































M.U.N.A.

This new course has been a tremendous success and Mrs. Stannard hopes more students will get involved with the new program next year. Remember, you don't have to be able to draw to take Art!




