


Four rows of peas: Perseverance, presence, preparation, promptness. Next plant three rows of Squash: Squash gossip, squash criticism, squash indifference.




We have gained insight into the mechanics of our school system, and learned not to take everything at face value. We have had the chance to see teachers and administrators as real people, not as teaching machines.

We returned on June 11th just in time for graduation.










































1975 INTERCHANGE ON CANADIAN STUDIES By Maureen Lowe
