#### IN MEMORIUM

The staff and students of Glenlawn Collegiate regret the passing of our Business Education teacher and friend, Mr. Nestor Budinsky, age 54, on Thursday, June 9, 1977 after a lengthy illness.

Mr. "Ness" Budinsky knew of his terminal illness for a number of years. He chose to display courage and show faith to all of us until the day he became so exhausted he had to be hospitalized. The strength, courage and faith he showed us indicated his upbringing, the kind of person he was.

Occasionally Mr. Budinsky spoke of his childhood; always on such occasions he spoke with great pleasure and thankfulness. Even in the greatest of pain and sorrow he expressed an element of joy. His attitude during the past few years was a fine balance of two truths; that life is worth living, and that death must be accepted without bitterness. Never had we heard him complain about his suffering.

Mr. Budinsky remained a friendly companion and helper to students and staff and family and friends right up to his final days. He would often be very tired, yet out of love and loyalty and dedication to his family and out of devotion to his work he courageously plodded on. He believed firmly in the necessity of hard work for social service and personal fulfillment. He never centered the meaning of his life around "getting and spending" but around the simple joys of being with people - family, friends and students. For Mr. Budinsky the "getting and spending" materialistic thrust on which many consume time and themselves was but the escape, the evasion, the dream on which people float out of existence, having cheated themselves of life.

Like most good teachers he wanted to provide his students with as much opportunity as possible to live and to learn and to be happy. He valued education highly and in May of this year, just before being hospitalized he received notice that the evening courses he had been taking for the past few years at the University of Manitoba had added up to a Bachelor of Pedagogy degree. His degree pleased him not from a pride in the outward symbols of learning but from an inner sense of achievement. He often preached about setting goals and then competing with oneself, rather than with others, in order to achieve them.

Mr. Nestor Budinsky's strength, courage and faith remind us of this message:

Don't let your life become a tale of woe of what you should have done or what you should have done or what you should have been. You alone are the determiner of the journey you will take and the choices you will make.

Don't let your epitaph read:

Too late I learned I could not be true to life without being true to me;  
Too late I learned it was my heart that would have set me free;  
Too late I discovered within myself the person I wanted to be.

It was never late for Mr. Nestor Budinsky. He will always be remembered!
