Although the success of the incoming council will be proportional to the student support, some of it will be due to those teachers who willingly volunteer their time and energy to the various clubs and teams.

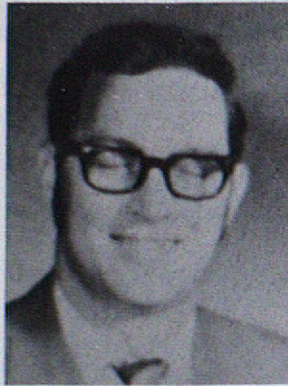
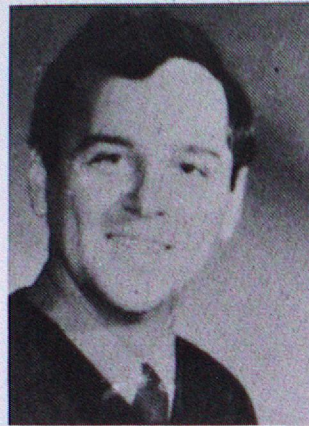
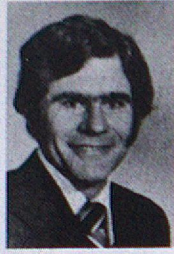
