I see within your eyes of blue.

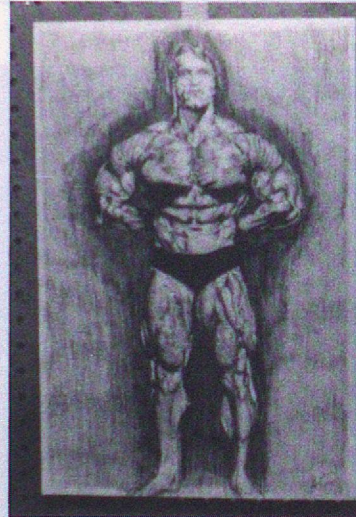
At last I know how far you see,
