In my deliberation about what I might say to graduates leaving Glenlawn I read a quotation by Calvin Coolidge - "The school is not the end but only the beginning of an education..."


Another quotation by Alan Bennet reads - "Education should be a journey ending up with you at a different place..."






The annual Glenlawn Spirit Week ran February 11-15. As usual the competition was fierce as students competed to win the championship for their grade.




















## BAND








### VARSITY GIRLS






















### Track and Field



### BOYS FASTBALL


