





When, in the future, we look back on our years at Glenlawn some of us may regard the time spent as a mere phase in our education, while others will enjoy a much fuller remembrance.




YEARBOOK EDITORIAL


theme and the one this spring with its Oriental flavor.



RUSS MUTH - With his scorching personality he leads the room's hootenanny. Interests are football, curling and water skiing.











Errington.


